12 land to be annexed is located must consent by order or resolution to

14 SECTION 2. Section 49.3021, Water Code, as added by this

Act, applies only to a petition requesting the annexation of land 15

received by a district board under Section 49.301 or 49.302, Water 16

Code, on or after the effective date of this Act. A petition 17

requesting the annexation of land received by a district board 18

under Section 49.301 or 49.302, Water Code, before the effective 19

20 date of this Act is governed by the law in effect on the date the

petition is received, and that law is continued in effect for that 21

22 purpose.
